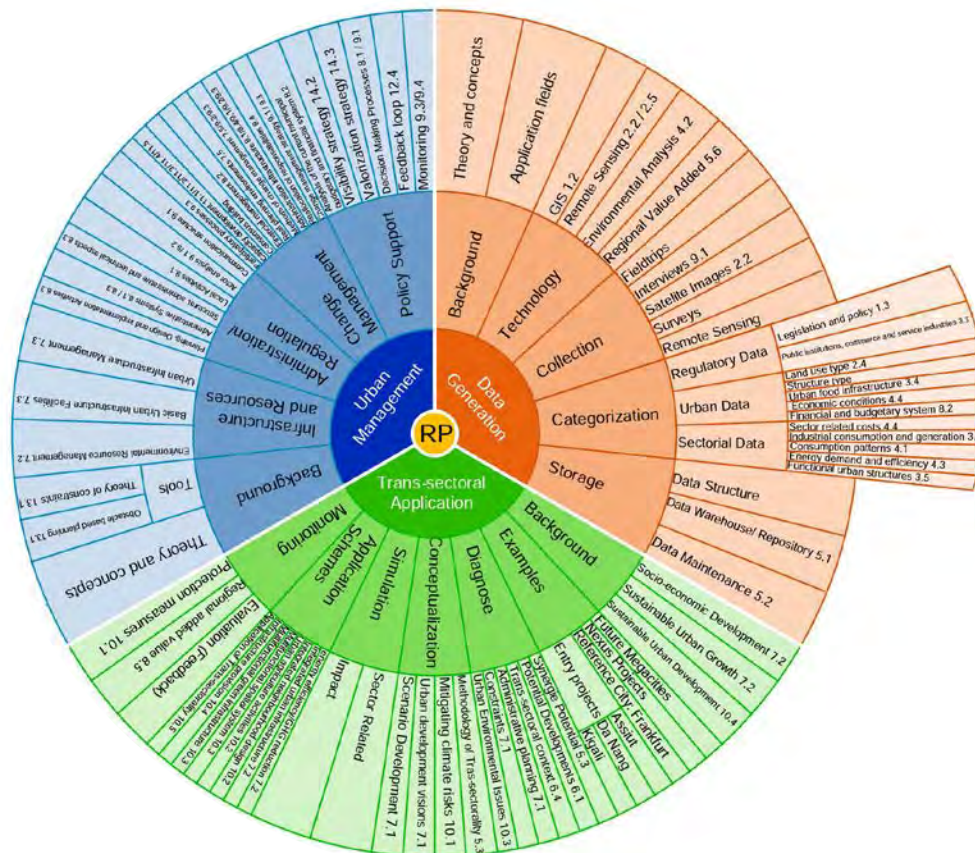

All knowledge generated by RP will be made available by a structured set of Knowledge Blocks



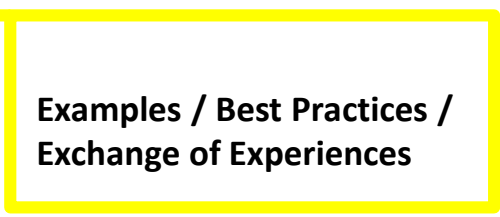
# Concept for an Internet based platform of Rapid Planning Knowledge Blocks

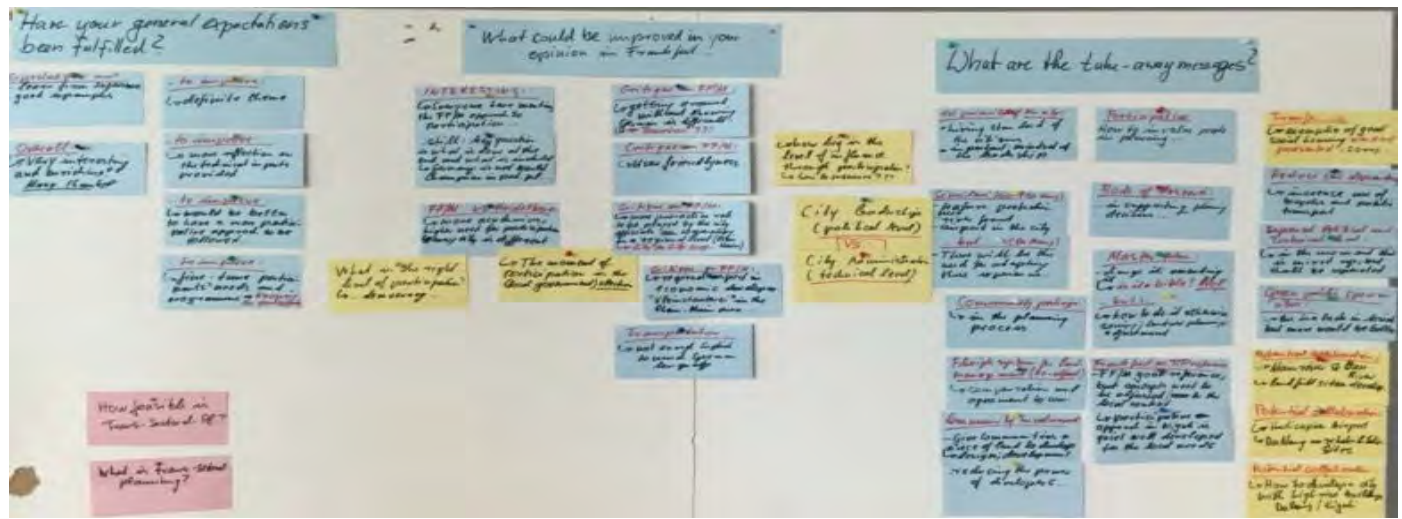
